

The word is derived from the root "to read" or "to recite"; hence, Qur'an is a verbal noun meaning reading or reciting.
2. What were the first verses from the Qur'an to be revealed? ___/2
**The first five verses from Surah Al-'Alaq (Surah 96):
أَفْرَأُ بِاسْمِ رَبِّكَ الَّذِي خَلَقَ (1) خَلَقَ الْإِنْسَانَ مِنْ عَلَقٍ (2) أَفْرَأُ وَرَبُّكَ الْأَكْرَمُ (3) الَّذِي عَلَّمَ بِالْقَلَمِ (4) عَلَّمَ الْإِنْسَانَ مَا لَمْ يَعْلَمْ (5)**
3. What was one of the last verses revealed to the Prophet Muhammad (pbuh)? ___/1

6. Mention four reasons the Qur'an revealed to the Prophet (pbuh) in stages? ___/4
 - **To strengthen the heart of the Prophet by addressing him continuously whenever the need for guidance arose.**
 - **To gradually implement the laws of Allah.**
 - **To make it easier for the Prophet to receive the revelations, since receiving the revelations was a very exhausting experience for him.**
 - **To make understanding, applying, and memorizing of the verses easier for the believers.**
7. Who were the companions who had memorized the Qur'an in its entirety and reviewed it with the Prophet (pbuh) before his death? ___/3

The exact significance is known only to Allah, and scholars have various explanations. A widely accepted explanation is that they are used to draw the attention of the listener to the fact that the following are Allah's words. Although they consist of the Arabic alphabet, they have a unique beauty and style and offer guidance to mankind.
10. When is a Surah called a 'Makkiyah' or Makkan Surah? ___/1
When the beginning of the surah was revealed before the Hijra, in Makkah.

11. When is a Surah called a 'Madaniyah'; Madinian Surah? ___/1
When the beginning of the surah was revealed after the Hijra in Madinah (even if some verses were revealed before Hijra).

When the Prophet (pbuh) sent a message to Heraclius, the Byzantine emperor, it contained a verse (3:64); the message was translated including that verse. Likewise, the Muslims translated the verse from Surah Maryam (19) regarding Prophet Isa (Christ) in front of the King of Abyssinia.

1. A Hadith regarding trust in Allah: ___/3
The Prophet (pbuh) said, "If you put all your **trust** in Allah, as you ought, He most certainly will satisfy your **needs**, as He satisfies those of the **birds**; they come out hungry in the morning, but return full to their nests." [Tirmithi]
2. A Hadith regarding being merciful to anyone: ___/2
The Prophet (pbuh) said, "Allah will not show mercy to anyone, except those who show **mercy** to other **creatures**." [Abu Dawood & Tirmithi]
3. A Hadith regarding telling the truth: ___/2
The Prophet (pbuh) said, "Say what is **true** although it may be bitter and displeasing to **people**." [Baihaqi]
4. A Hadith regarding kindness: ___/2
The Prophet (pbuh) said, "**Kindness** is a mark of faith, and whoever is not kind has no **faith**." [Muslim]
5. A Hadith regarding being in the company of good people: ___/3
The Prophet (pbuh) said, "It is better to sit alone, than in the company of **bad** people; and it is better still to sit with good company than **alone**. It is better to speak to a seeker of **knowledge** than to remain silent; but silence is better than idle words." [Bukhari]
6. A Hadith regarding loving one another: ___/3
The Prophet (pbuh) said, "You will not enter **paradise** until you have **faith**; and you will not complete your faith until you **love** one another." [Muslim]
7. A Hadith regarding the importance of Qur'an and the Sunnah: ___/3
The Prophet (pbuh) said, "I am leaving two things among you, and if you cling to them firmly you will never go **astray**; one is the **Book of Allah** and the other is my **way of life** (Sunnah)." [Muatta]

8. Mention five people who conveyed most of the Prophet's sayings and actions to other Muslims. ___/5

- **His wife, A'iysha, who had a remarkable memory and who lived for 48 years after his death (2210 Hadith)**
- **His companion, Abu Hurairah, who was constantly with the Prophet and who had no worries about earning his livelihood as he was the Prophet's guest (5374 Hadith)**
- **His servant Anas (2286 Hadith)**
- **Abdullah Ibn Umar (2630 Hadith)**
- **Abdullah Ibn Abbas (1660 Hadith)**

9. How were early Muslims taught hadeeth after the Prophet's death? ___/2

Yes, Abu Hurairah had a school with 800 students where he taught hadeeth. Also Caliph 'Omar sent companions like Abdullah ibn Masoud and Abu Hurairah to different parts of the Muslim world to teach the hadeeth.

Prophet Zakariya (Zachariah) and Prophet Yahya (John the Baptist).
3. To whom was Prophet Hud sent? ___/1
To 'Aad, an ancient people living in a land between Arabia and Yemen.
4. What happened to the people of 'Aad, after they disobeyed Prophet Hud? ___/1
They were destroyed by a fierce wind, which Allah caused to blow against them for seven nights and eight days.
5. To whom was Prophet Saleh sent? ___/1
To Thamood, an ancient people living in a land between Arabia and Sham.
6. How did Allah punish the people of Thamood, after they disobeyed Prophet Saleh? ___/1
They were destroyed by a terrible earthquake.
7. What is the story of Prophet Yusuf with his brothers? ___/2
When Yusuf's brothers noticed that he was the best-loved son by their father, they were filled with envy and hatred. They plotted to get rid of him and threw him into a well. Some merchants found him and sold him to an Egyptian minister who had great wealth and power.

He taught his fellow prisoners the message of Truth and he was known for Allah's gift of interpreting dreams.
