2.	A Hadith regarding being merciful to anyone:/2 The Prophet (pbuh) said, "Allah will not show mercy to anyone, except those who show mercy to other creatures." [Abu Dawood & Tirmithi]
3.	A Hadith regarding telling the truth:/2 The Prophet (pbuh) said, "Say what is true although it may be bitter and displeasing to people." [Baihaqi]
4.	A Hadith regarding kindness:/2 The Prophet (pbuh) said, "Kindness is a mark of faith, and whoever is not kind has no faith." [Muslim]

A Hadith regarding being in the company of good people:  The Prophet (pbuh) said, "It is better to sit alone, than in the company of <a href="bad">bad</a> people; and it is better still to sit with good company than <a href="alone">alone</a> . It is better to speak to a seeker of <a href="knowledge">knowledge</a> than to remain silent; but silence is better than idle words." [Bukhari]
